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PROJECT OBJECTIVES



1. PROJECT CONTEXT OVERVIEW

3. MAIN PROJECT RESULTS



A good practices guide, based on case studies of green business in the 8 partner countries, will be created.

A simple and suggestive Green Business Innovation Canvas (GBIC) will be defined providing a visual method with points to follow to start a business model in which green features and sustainable processes can be inserted.

An e-learning platform, freely available for adult educational staff and entrepreneurs will be developed. The platform (available in 7 languages) will offer all InnoGreen educational materials: good practices guide for green businesses, GBIC step-by-step completion guide, animated videos, a GBIC online interactive tool & Guidelines for training on innovation in business models.

FIRST PROJECT MEETING



1. WELCOME AND PROJECT ACTIVITIES PRESENTATION

Partners are currently working on the interviews with SME owners and entrepreneurs as models of green businesses that carry out green practices at a local level. The main findings of the interviews collected in Romania, Italy, Portugal, Greece, Malta, Poland and Switzerland will be published and available online and collected in a good practice guide.
