## WORKSHOP 4 IN POLAND

Partners met for the fourth transnational project meeting and workshop in Jelena Gora (Poland) on April 3-5 2024. PCKK organized the final workshop which brought together adult educators, volunteers, and practitioners from across Europe to discuss and share effective strategies for integrating immigrants at the national, regional, and local levels.

In the last months, each partner created the training material under the form of Open Educational Resources (OERs) for each of the 4 training modules ( see next page).

Partner also took part to different cultural activities aimed at exchanging ideas, share experiences, and develop strategies for promoting integration and building inclusive communities.

The workshop shared successful models for recruiting, training, and supporting volunteers to ensure their effectiveness and satisfaction.



## KEY TAKEAWAYS

- **Understanding the needs of immigrants:** Participants explored the diverse challenges and opportunities faced by immigrants, including language barriers, cultural differences, and access to services.
- **The role of volunteers:** The workshop emphasized the invaluable contributions of volunteers in providing practical support, emotional assistance, and cultural orientation to immigrants.
- **Building inclusive communities:** Participants discussed strategies for creating welcoming and supportive communities where immigrants can thrive and actively participate in social life.

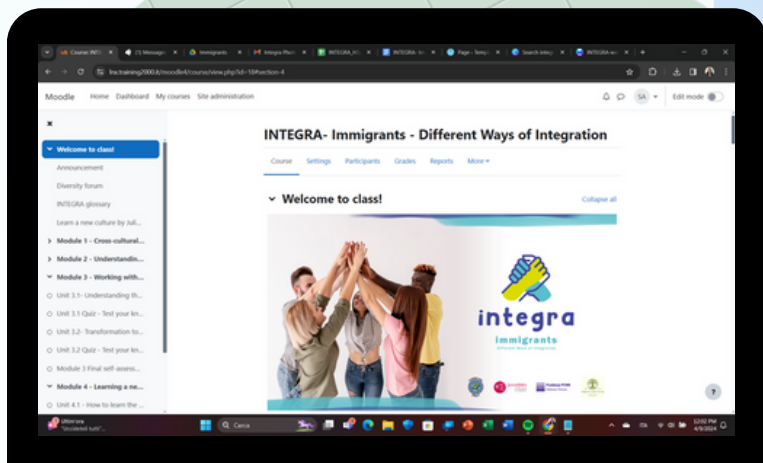
### RESULT 2: THE E-LEARNING COURSE

This INTEGRA online course aims at developing key lifelong learning competences of migrants, adult educators, volunteers and public representative working in the field of social inclusion.

Partner discussed the progress of the INTEGRA online course composed by 4 modules, namely:

- **MODULE 1 - Cross cultural awareness**
- **MODULE 2 - understanding Different Cultures**
- **MODULE 3 - Working with Stereotype**
- **MODULE 4 - Learning foreign languages in the host country (videos).**

Each module is based on a set of digital training materials ( text, videos, quizzes, self-assessment tests) published as Open Educational Resources (OER), freely accessible from the project website in multiple languages ( PL,IT,DA,ES).



### PILOT TESTING IN PARTNERS COUNTRY

In May 2024 partners started the pilot testing phase in their country to evaluate the INTEGRA online course with immigrants, host community representatives and educators/trainers working for the integration of immigrants in their communities. We gained valuable insights into the course's strengths, weaknesses, and areas for enhancement. The findings helped us to refine of the online course, ensuring its optimal impact on immigrant integration efforts.

### NEXT STEPS

- **Dissemination of project findings:** each project results and resource will be available on the INTEGRA website together with videos, photos and study visit report from each international workshop.
- **Continued Collaboration:** The INTEGRA project will continue to foster collaboration and knowledge exchange among its partners and stakeholders. We are committed to supporting the development and implementation of effective integration strategies across Europe!
